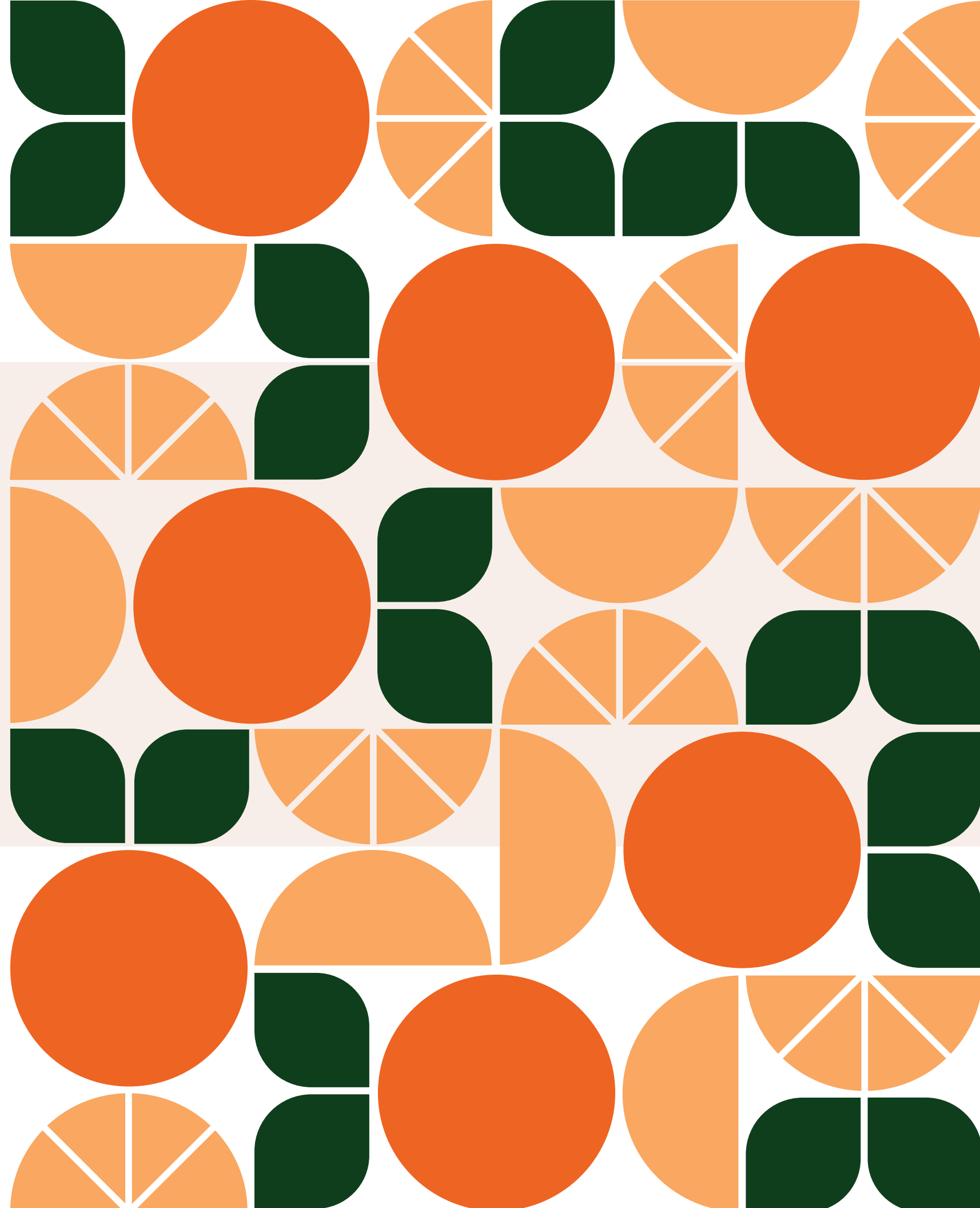

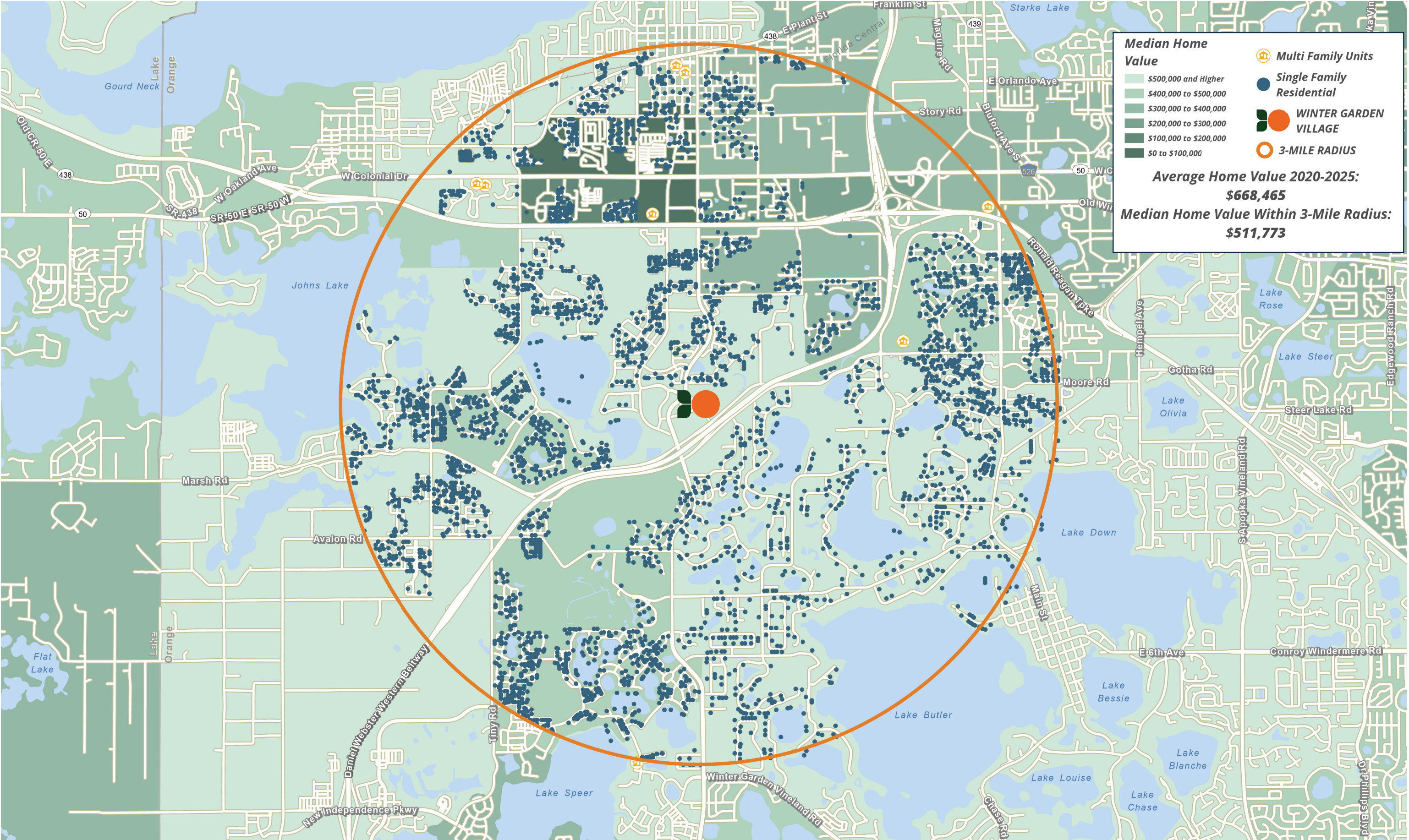


Submarket Map | Winter Garden Village





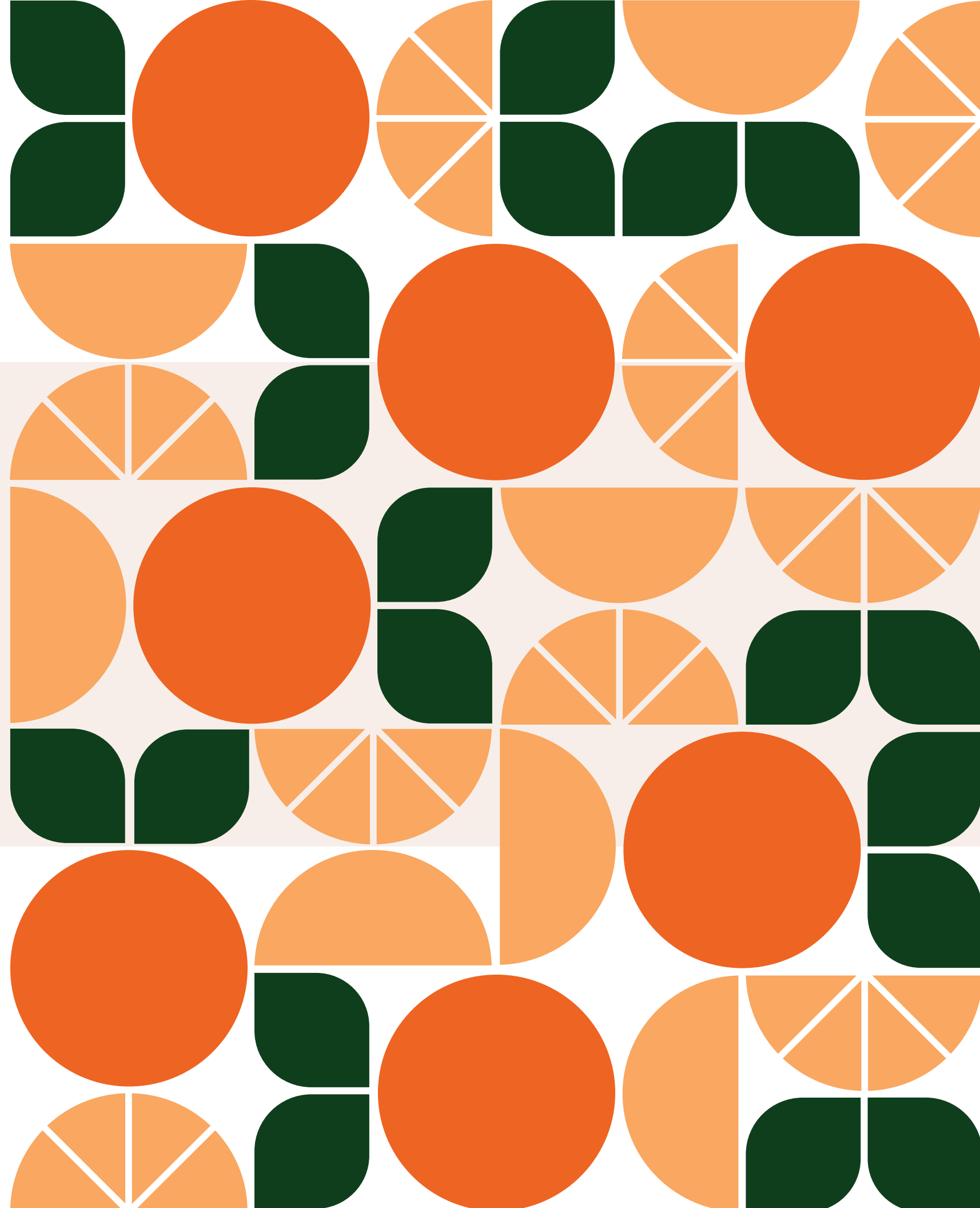
# Home Value Sales Map | Winter Garden Village

Located in western Orange County about 14 miles west of downtown Orlando and 10 miles north of Walt Disney World Resort, Winter Garden blends small-town charm with the energy of a rapidly growing suburb. Founded in the 1850s near Lake Apopka, the city’s agricultural roots in citrus farming have evolved into a thriving family-centric community focused on connectedness, outdoor living, and a vibrant sense of place. Its motto, “A charming little city with a juicy past,” reflects that heritage. The historic downtown along Plant Street features vintage architecture, walkable streets, cafés, boutiques, and cultural venues, while major roadways such as SR-429 and The Florida Turnpike connect residents to regional employment centers and tourism destinations.

Winter Garden’s population has more than doubled since 2000, reflecting its appeal to families and professionals seeking quality schools, housing, and amenities. With a growing affluent population and a majority of residents being homeowners, the purchasing power in Winter Garden is strong. The community craves best-in-class retailers, dining, and services. # Orlando

It is home to over 120 companies, has one of the largest universities in the country (University of Central Florida), and is the hub of the nation’s military simulation and training programs.
